COMMON WILDFLOWERS:

<input type="checkbox"/>		DANDELION (<i>Taraxacum officinale</i>)	<i>Yellow, daisy-like flowers</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>		VIOLET (<i>Viola</i> spp.)	<i>Purple, five-petaled flowers</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>		CONEFLOWER (<i>Echinacea purpurea</i>)	<i>Pink/purple flowers with a prominent center cone</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>		MILKWEED (<i>Asclepias</i> spp.)	<i>Clusters of small, pink or white flowers</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>		CLOVER (<i>Trifolium</i> spp.)	<i>Small, white or pink flowers in clusters</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>		DAISY (<i>Leucanthemum vulgare</i>)	<i>White petals with yellow center</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>		LUPINE (<i>Lupinus</i> spp.)	<i>Tall spikes of blue, purple, or white flowers</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>		FIREWEED (<i>Chamerion angustifolium</i>)	<i>Tall stalks with pink or purple flowers</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>		BLACK-EYED SUSAN (<i>Rudbeckia hirta</i>)	<i>Yellow petals with dark brown center</i>

*Three-petaled white or
pink flowers*

flowers*

(Dicentra spp.)

*Heart-shaped, pink or
white flowers*
