COMMON WILDFLOWERS:

	DANDELION (Taraxacum officinale)	Yellow, daisy-like flowers
	VIOLET (Viola spp.)	Purple, five-petaled flowers
	CONEFLOWER (Echinacea purpurea)	Pink/purple flowers with a prominent center cone
	MILKWEED (Asclepias spp.)	Clusters of small, pink or white flowers
	CLOVER (Trifolium spp.)	Small, white or pink flowers in clusters
	DAISY (Leucanthemum vulgare)	White petals with yellow center
	LUPINE (Lupinus spp.)	Tall spikes of blue, purple, or white flowers
	FIREWEED (Chamerion angustifolium)	Tall stalks with pink or purple flowers
VIII	BLACK-EYED SUSAN (Rudbeckia hirta)	Yellow petals with dark brown center
